• The sun warms water. • Clouds are connected to rain. • Water can be found in oceans, lakes, and rivers.	• How does liquid water get into the air? • Why do clouds form? • Does the same water keep moving through the cycle?	• Evaporation changes liquid water into water vapor. • Condensation happens when water vapor cools and forms droplets. • Precipitation returns water to Earth; collection stores it before the cycle continues.
